EXTERIOR TASKS

- O Inspect wood siding for peeling or flaking paint, wood rot, moss or mildew, protruding nails and lifted siding.
- O Look for holes or small crevices where animals could have invaded.
- O Evaluate & repair caulking around windows, doors, and other entry points for bugs, animals, or water intrusion.
- O Inspect for settling cracks in the foundation and cracks in concrete steps, walkways, and driveway.
- Check the roof for missing or damaged shingles, moss growth, and clean gutters.
- O Spray for bugs around the exterior of the home, with special attention to potential termite damage.
- Inspect windows & screens for damage, wash windows, and clean exterior window tracks.
- O Clean, reseal, or re-paint/re-stain exterior decks.
- Have a professional powerwash your home's exterior.
- Ensure the ground slopes away from your home and that downspouts direct water away from the foundation.
- Reseal asphalt driveways if needed.
- O Inspect exterior sprinkler heads and systems if needed.
- Mow overgrown weeds and trim shrubs or trees so they're at least 6" away from the foundation & exterior walls.
- Turn on hose bibs and irrigation systems. Check for leaks or cracked pipes from winter freezes.

INTERIOR TASKS

- O Check for dampness or musty smells throughout the home, including closets and closed-off spaces.
- Inspect for water and weather damage inside and outside storage sheds. Replace the weather stripping if necessary.
- Have the HVAC system inspected and tuned up by a professional to verify the ac is functional before the heat hits.
- Replace HVAC filters, standing air filters, and humidifier filters.
- Clean and reverse the direction of your ceiling fans.
- Give your home a deep clean, focusing on dust-prone spots. Don't skip the dryer lint trap or garbage disposal.
- Remove soap scum from bathroom surfaces and clear hair from bath and shower drains.
- Replace window and door screens and tighten loose screws.
- O Touch up or repaint interior walls.
- Inspect and maintain seals and caulking around showers, countertops, backsplashes, toilets, and bathtubs.
- Inspect the garage door's track and springs for proper functioning.
- Remove any remains from a wood-burning fireplace and clean out any buildup.
- O Clean showerheads of grime and sediment buildup.
- Check that smoke detectors, fire extinguishers, and carbon monoxide detectors are in working order & have batteries.
- Inspect attic & insulation for signs of condensation, pests or water intrusion.
- Service hot water heater to flush sediment buildup to improve efficiency and extended life.
- O Inspect electrical panel for loose wires, tripped or faulty breakers, and water intrusion.
